


One shot for Coastal Carnivores

PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBIT

In support of efforts to permanently end trophy hunting of all large carnivores on the coast of British Columbia, Raincoast is curating a photography collection - One shot for Coastal Carnivores. Donated pieces will tell the stories of the importance of protecting coastal carnivores. Pieces will be auctioned to support fundraising efforts and exhibited in Vancouver, Victoria and Whistler through October - December 2018. The gallery exhibits, speaker events and a social media campaign will help engage and inspire thousands.

THE CAMPAIGN GOAL

In partnership with Coastal First Nations, Raincoast is working to acquire all commercial hunting tenures in the Great Bear Rainforest. Our current target is the Nadeea tenure. Once acquired, commercial hunting in these areas will permanently end. Proceeds will contribute to our current financial target of \$500,000.
